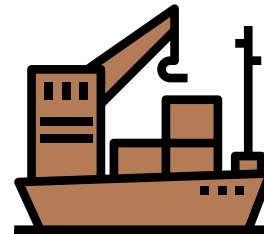


FLOORING DISTRIBUTION DELAYS: COVID-19'S EFFECT



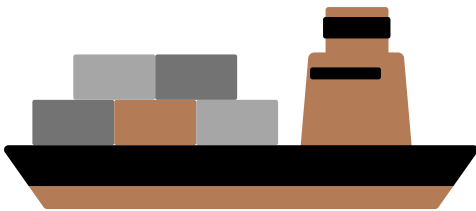
STEP #1: MANUFACTURER

- Reduced Labor at Factory ➤ Extended Lead Times
- Increased Production in Asia ➤ Fewer Containers Available
- Fewer Containers Available ➤ Higher container price



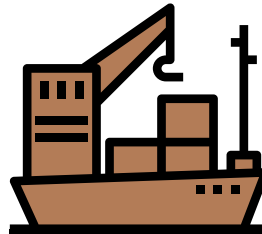
STEP #2: OVERSEAS PORT

- Truck Driver Shortage ➤ Delayed Arrival to Port
- Fewer Active Containers ➤ Less Cargo for Ships
- Reduced Labor at Port ➤ Longer Dock Cycle



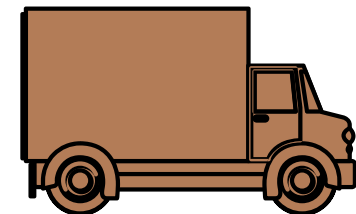
STEP #3: SHIPPING VESSEL

- Less Cargo for Ships ➤ Fewer Active Ships
- Overseas Shipping ➤ 30+ Day Travel Time
- Congested Ports ➤ Anchored for Weeks



STEP #4: U.S. PORT

- Reduced Labor at Port ➤ Longer Dock Cycle
- Outbreaks at Destination ➤ Container Sits at Port Yard



STEP #5: TRUCK

- Container Chassis Shortage ➤ Delayed Container Pickup
- Truck Driver Shortage ➤ Longer Delivery Time
